Who Is Eligible for Health Coverage Programs?

Low-income San Mateo County residents can apply. Eligibility is based on income and family size:

- Adults who work and children with working parents may also be eligible.
- Immigrants may also be eligible for some programs, regardless of immigration status.

What You Need to Bring for Your Application

Proof of home address in San Mateo County

A recent utilily bill, billing statement, letter, or ID that has your address

Proof of income or financial support

If you have income, a recent employment pay stub, government check stub (unemployment or disability), or tax forms from the previous year are accepted; if you do not have income, a letter of financial support is necessary.

Proof of identity

Any state ID card, or ID from country of origin, or passport

- Social Security Number (if applicable)
- Proof of U.S. citizenship or resident status (for U.S. citizens and legal permanent residents) U.S. citizens can bring passport, birth or naturalization certificate (originals only, no photo copies). Legal U.S. residents can bring their residency card.
