



Health Coverage Enrollment Assistance in San Mateo County for Adults and Children

Who Is Eligible for Health Coverage Programs?

Low-income San Mateo County residents can apply. Eligibility is based on income and family size:

- Adults who work and children with working parents may also be eligible.
- Immigrants may also be eligible for some programs, regardless of immigration status.

What You Need to Bring for Your Application

- **Proof of home address in San Mateo County**
A recent utility bill, billing statement, letter, or ID that has your address
- **Proof of income or financial support**
If you have income, a recent employment pay stub, government check stub (unemployment or disability), or tax forms from the previous year are accepted; if you do not have income, a letter of financial support is necessary.
- **Proof of identity**
Any state ID card, or ID from country of origin, or passport
- **Social Security Number (if applicable)**
- **Proof of U.S. citizenship or resident status (for U.S. citizens and legal permanent residents)**
U.S. citizens can bring passport, birth or naturalization certificate (originals only, no photo copies). Legal U.S. residents can bring their residency card.
