

## Election/Campaigning Rules

- Campaigning will begin on **Monday, March 25th** and will end on the last day of voting- **Tuesday, April 2nd.**
- The election will be held on **Tuesday, April 2nd** and voting will take place via google form. Students will need to be logged-in to their JUHSD log in. We reserve the right to postpone voting a later date, which would only serve to give you more time to campaign.
- All candidates may campaign with posters/flyers **but absolutely no stickers of any kind.**
- **Absolutely no home-made food or candy etc may be distributed as part of your campaign.**
  - You are allowed to pass out items such as buttons, balloons or flyers
- All campaign posters/flyers, statements, social media posts regarding your campaign **MUST** all be positive in nature and only promote you and not disparage others running for ASB positions.
- Posters can be displayed anywhere on the outside of the the buildings, in the building hallways, or in the quad. You may only hang posters inside classrooms **with teacher permission.**
- All posters/flyers **MUST** be hung up with blue painters tape (this is a school requirement). Due to the cost of blue tape - ASB will provide tape to candidates if requested. Please make request directly to Mrs. Deleon.
- All posters/flyers must be removed by **(Tuesday, April 2nd)**
- Although you are not responsible for the actions of your friends, I would ask that you speak to your friends about helping you run a positive campaign. Their actions could reflect negatively on your campaign with your peers.
- You **may not** use ASB paper, supplies or copiers.
- You **may not** demean or slander any competing candidate. If you do, you will be automatically disqualified.
- Any violation of these rules may result in a candidate's removal from the election.
- All communication with you will take place over your **JHS school e-mail**. Please be sure to check it regularly for interview, voting, and other campaign information.

**BIGGEST REMINDER:** The purpose of you running for a position in ASB **should** be for your desire to be involved and better the school as a whole. That being said, it is my expectation that you conduct yourself in a manner that is fitting of a leader. Win or lose, you **may** still end up with a position within ASB and will need to work with each other - again, for the betterment of the school. You **do not** want to enter the year on a bad note. It will not be good for the group or for the school.
