### Detailed Reading Schedule

<b>Thursday, March 19th</b>	Begin reading <i>When the Elephants Dance</i>  <b>Part I Alejandro Karangalan</b> Read pages: 3-24 (end with last sentence that reads, "His face is the last thing I remember")
<b>Friday, March 20th</b>	Read pages: 24 (start with "When I wake a few hours later...") to page 47 (end with "Yes, Father, I shall try to give more.")

<b>Monday, March 23rd</b>	Read pages: 47 (start with “After the padre left...”) to page 68 (end with “I see in my sister in my dreams.....”)
<b>Tuesday, March 24th</b>	Read pages: 68 (start with “In the morning I hear....”) to page 99 (end with “I had dreams that he stood.....”)
<b>Wednesday, March 25th</b>	Read pages: 99 (start with, “On the morning of...”) to end of Part I <b>Reading Log and Chunk Paragraph due</b>
<b>Thursday, March 26th</b>	<b>Part 2 Isabelle Karangalan</b> Read pages: 117 to page 130 (end with “Domingo drives the knife....”).
<b>Friday, March 27th</b>	Read pages: 130 (start with “We leave the cave...” to page 144 (end with “He could have been the worst...”)
<b>Monday, March 30th</b>	Read pages: 144 (start with “It is dark in the room” to page 163 (“But I became bitter...”)
<b>Tuesday, March 31st</b>	Read “Ghost Children” (page 163 to page 178 “I heard that all night long...”)
<b>Wednesday, April 1st</b>	Finish reading “Ghost Children” starting from page 178 “As we grew.... To page 207.
<b>Thursday, April 2nd</b>	Complete reading Part 2 <b>Reading Log and Chunk Paragraph due</b>
