Course Selection Process



- All students have to take *6 classes* every year
- Counselors will meet with students in their History/Freshman Seminar/Health classes to review their transcripts and input their course requests
- Students will bring home their course selections forms for parent/guardian review and signature

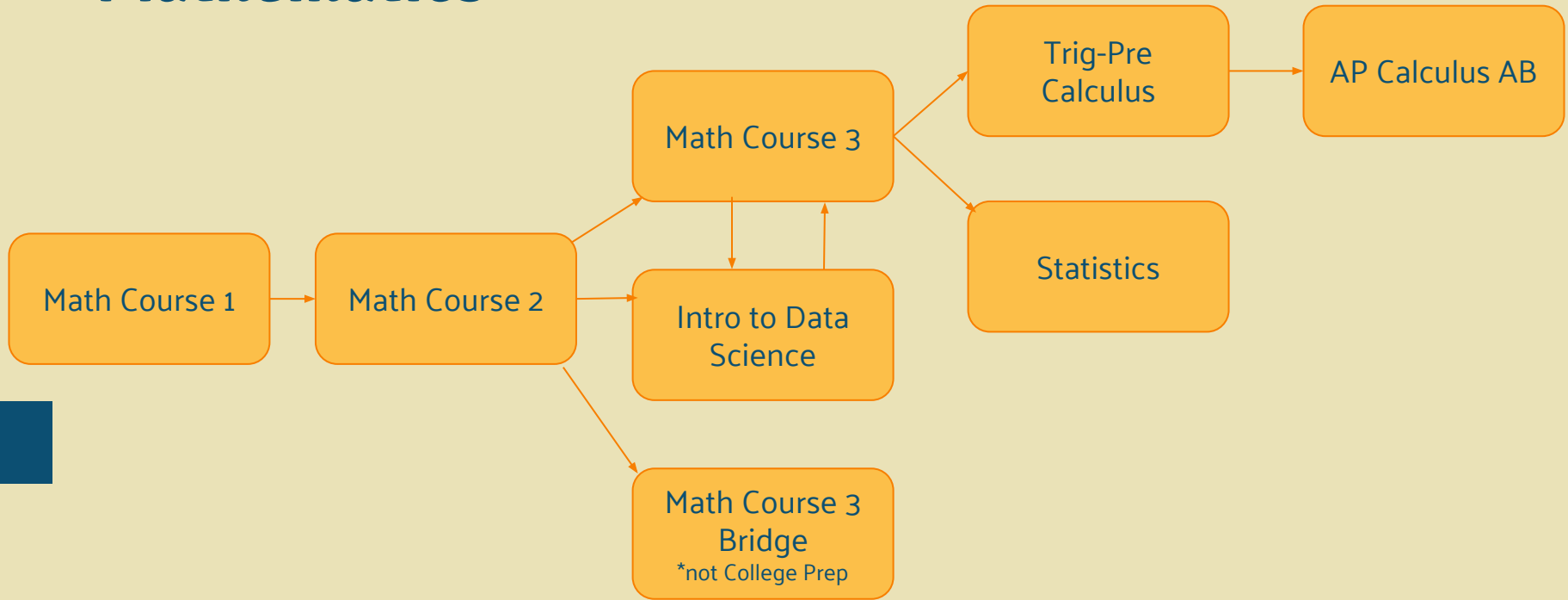

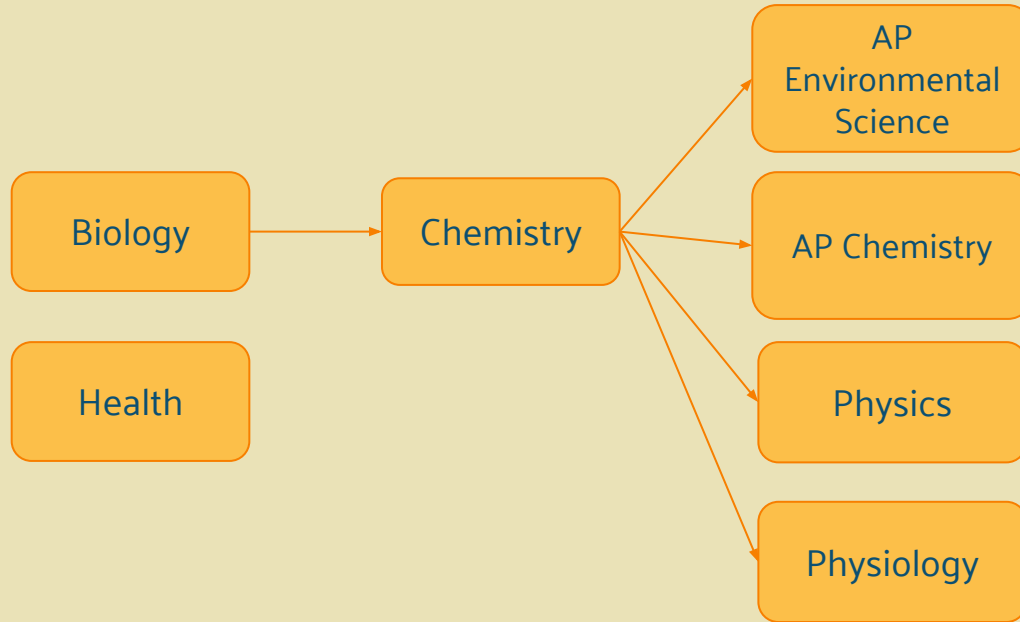
