breakfast and lunch for 3 days.

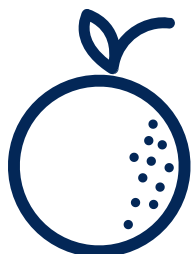
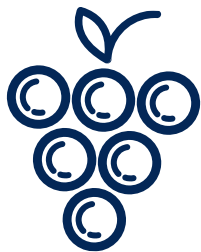
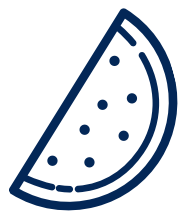
**Fridays 1-3**

## Who

Beginning September 4,  
amilies can pick up meal  
packets for **any child  
under 18 years old** in  
their household, whether  
or not the child is present  
for meal pickup.

**No IDs are required.**



## Please observe these rules:

- Congregating in groups is not allowed.
- People arriving by car should not leave the vehicle.
- People walking on to campus should go to the designated lunch distribution area only.
- Distributed food must be consumed or refrigerated by 5 p.m.
- Meals will not be consumed on site.

## Other Food Resources

### Second Harvest Food Bank

## Why are these changes happening?

The federal government reinstated the Seamless Summer Program, which allows schools to feed all children, regardless of their school of attendance. The program was temporarily suspended between August 11 - 31.
