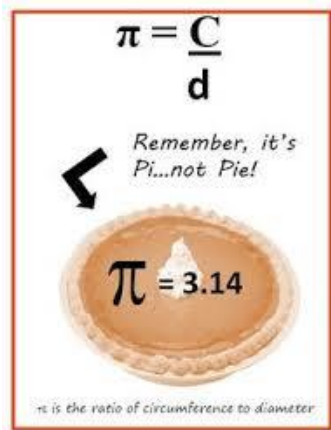


The Math Department in celebration of Pi-Day

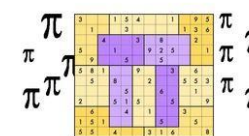

Pi Day Sudoku

The rules are a little different from standard Sudoku, in part because the blocks are jigsaw pieces rather than 3x3, and in part because the first 12 digits of pi are used instead of the standard 1-9. Each row, each column, and each colored block ("jigsaw region") contains the first 12 digits of pi: 3, 1, 4, 1, 5, 9, 2, 6, 5, 3, 5, 8. In particular, there are two 3s, two 5s, one 4, three 6s, one 8, one 9 and one 9.
