Instructions on how to use Palo Alto GlobalProtect VPN on a computer running Microsoft Windows.

How To: JUHSD VPN Client Installation Instructions – Windows

1. Using any web browser, go to <https://vpn.juhsd.net>
2. Login with your Network credentials



3. Click the link to download the Windows 64 bit or 32 bit GlobalProtect Agent

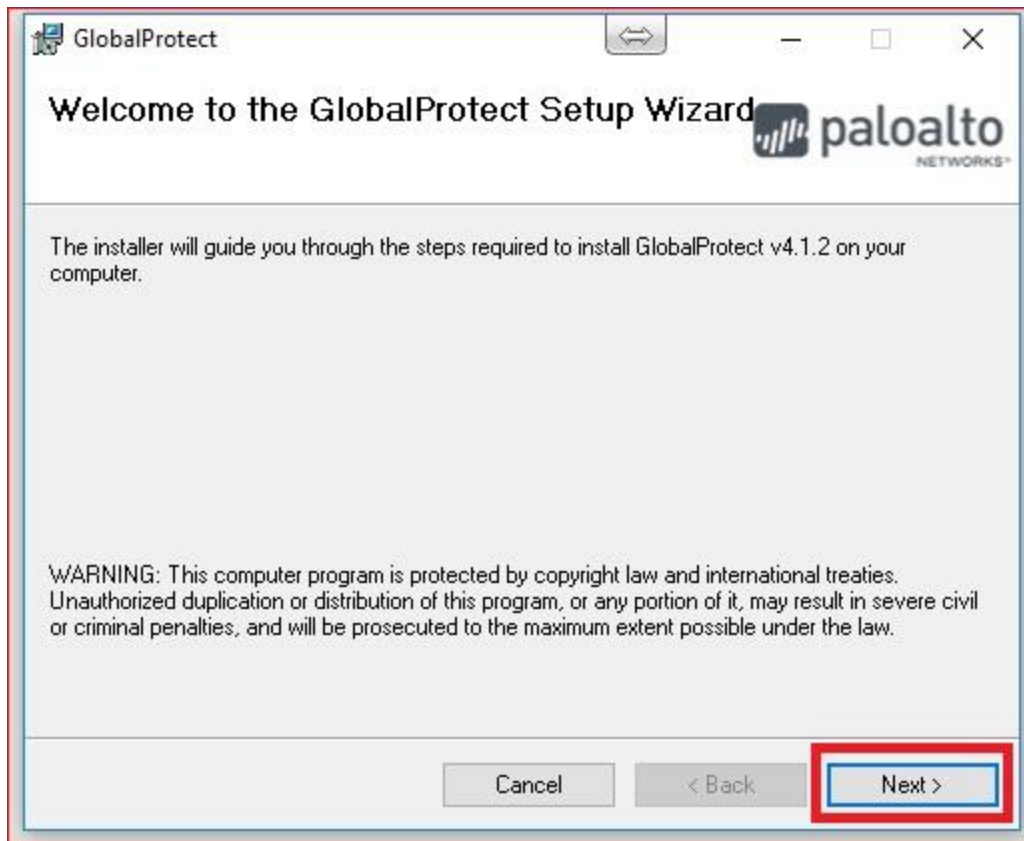

Windows 32 bit OS needs to download and install Windows 32 bit GlobalProtect agent.

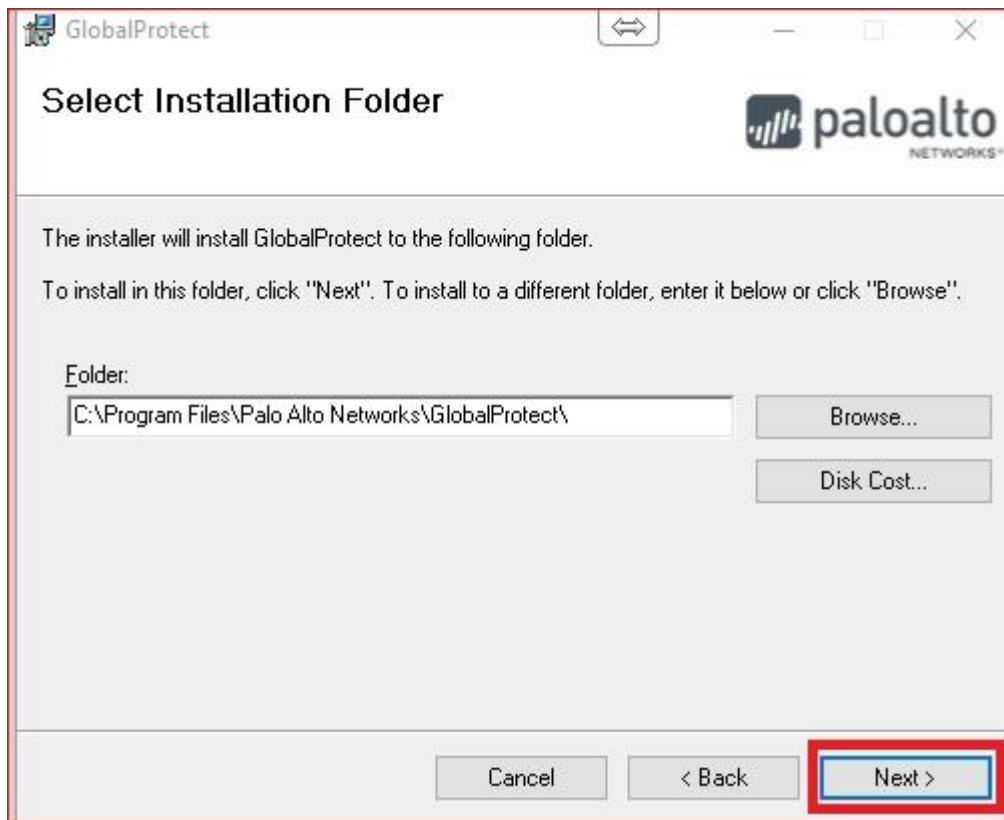
Windows 64 bit OS needs to download and install Windows 64 bit GlobalProtect agent.

Mac OS needs to download and install Mac 32/64 bit GlobalProtect agent.

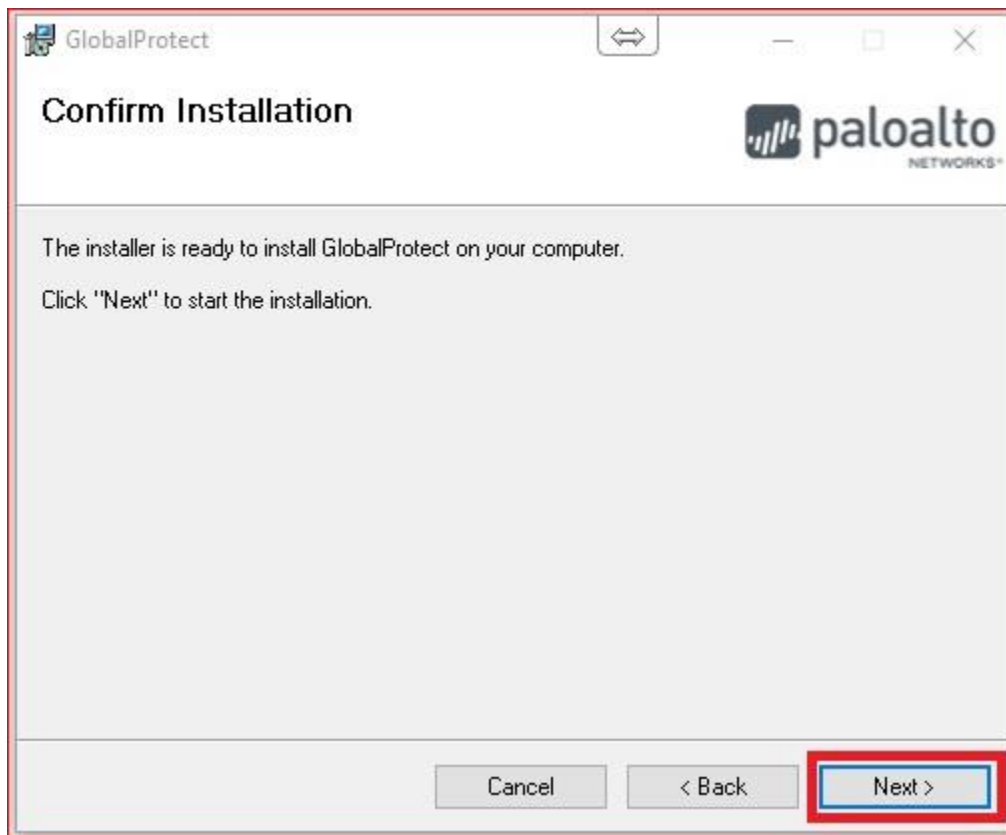
4. Click "Next" to continue.



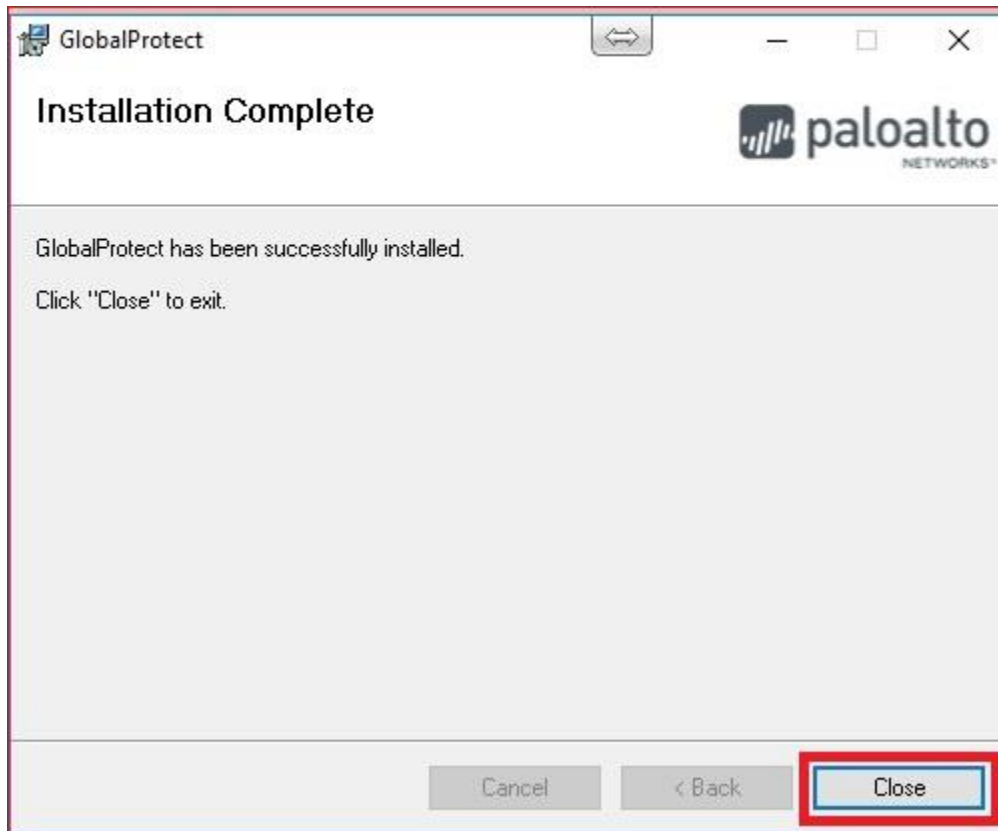
5. Click "Next" to continue again.



6. Click "Next" to continue again.



7. Click "Close" to exit.



8. If the VPN Client doesn't pop up automatically, in the bottom right corner of the screen click the GlobalProtect Icon.



9. In the box that appears type "vpn.juhsd.net" as it appears in the picture and click the blue "Connect" button.



10. Wait for the VPN to prompt you for authentication and then sign into the VPN using your credentials.

11. Wait for the VPN to connect.



12. You will know when you are connected to VPN when the client tells you (see picture below).
