## TRAFFIC CHANGES FOR TN IN THE NEW YEAR

Earlier this school year, a traffic consultancy firm was hired to study the traffic around our campus. This was done in response to several accidents that have involved Terra Nova students and multiple near misses that could have resulted in serious injuries and bodily harm.

Starting January 7<sup>th</sup>, the following changes will take effect on our campus:

◇ All cars will ENTER through the southern driveway (nearest the baseball field)

◇ All cars will EXIT through the northern driveway (nearest the staff parking lot)

◇ Traffic exiting campus will be split into two lanes

Right-hand turn lane onto Terra Nova Blvd

Left-hand turn lane onto Terra Nova Blvd



◇ Cars leaving the stadium parking lot must exit campus through the northern driveway

Over the break, the parking lot will be painted to reflect these changes.

Your support and understanding is appreciated while we transition to these new changes. They are being implemented to keep our students and visitors safe while traveling on our campus. Staff members will be out directing traffic when school resumes.

We also recognize the traffic difficulties that exist off of our campus. The traffic study included additional recommendations, and we will continue to work with the City of Pacifica to implement these improvements.

## PSAT ACCESS

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of the Classes of 2020 and 2021,

On October 10, all sophomores and juniors in the Jefferson Union High School District participated in the first annual College and Career Readiness day. All sophomores and juniors who took the PSAT/NMSQT should have received an email on Wednesday, October 12 with information for accessing their scores. Students who did not provide their email on the answer document will not have received this email from the College Board. This email, included an 'access code' to view online score reports.

Any student who did not provide an email address, do not worry. In either scenario, the first step to accessing score reports is to create a College Board account. This account will **only** need to be created once.

Paper score reports will also be provided to each sophomore and junior when we return from the semester break. The counseling staff will go into classrooms and hand out score reports and discuss the interpretation of the scores for each section. Specific dates and additional information will be emailed to all families during the week of January 7.

Below are helpful documents for parent(s)/guardian(s) to aid in understanding these scores including information regarding the Khan Academy online support for your students that will help to improving academic achievement and provide tutorials for SAT preparation.

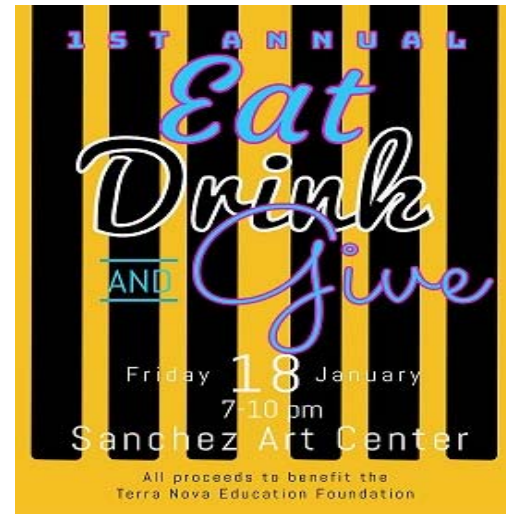
## Terra Nova Education Foundation

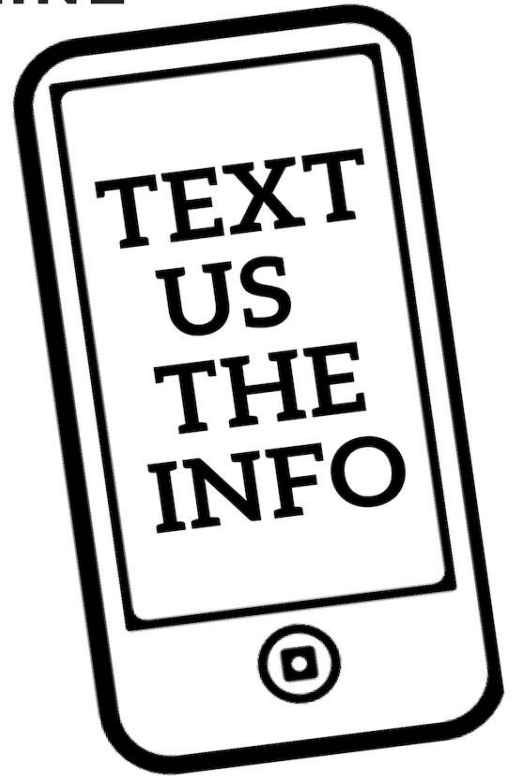

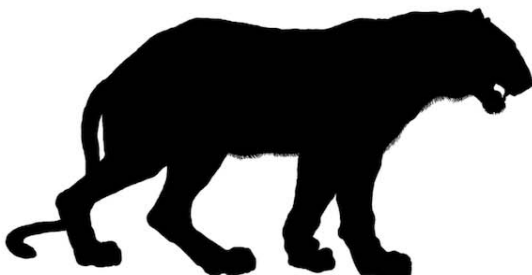
