MEASURE E

To protect quality education for all students, with funds that cannot be taken by the State, by: enhancing math, science, reading and writing skills; providing career training and college preparation; providing 21st century computer instruction; attracting and retaining qualified teachers; shall Jefferson Union High School District replace its expiring education parcel tax at \$60 per year for 10 years, beginning July 1, 2016 on each assessor's parcel located within the Jefferson Union High School District, with an exemption available for senior citizens, recipients of SSI for a disability and recipients of SSDI benefits if below a certain yearly income level, and to implement fiscal accountability measures in conjunction with the temporary levy, which will benefit all of the District's high school?
